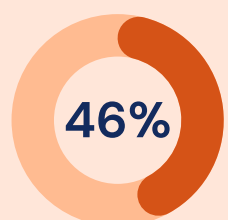


Top 5 Cybersecurity Excuses Hurting Your Business

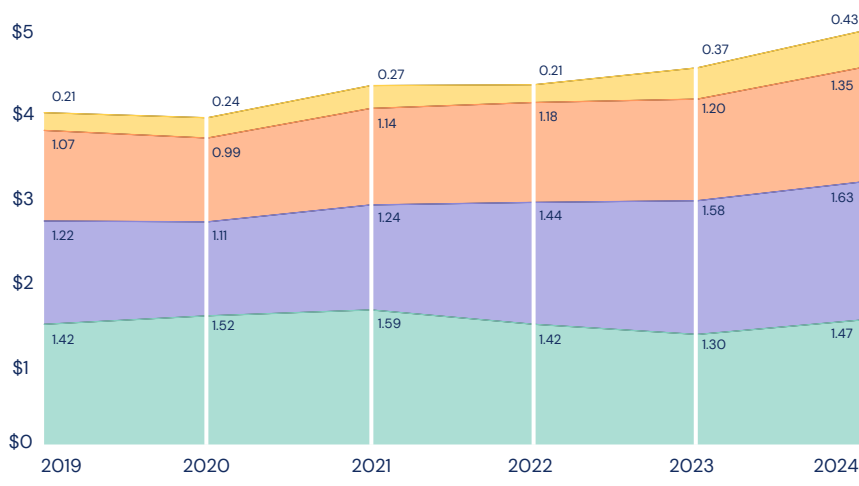

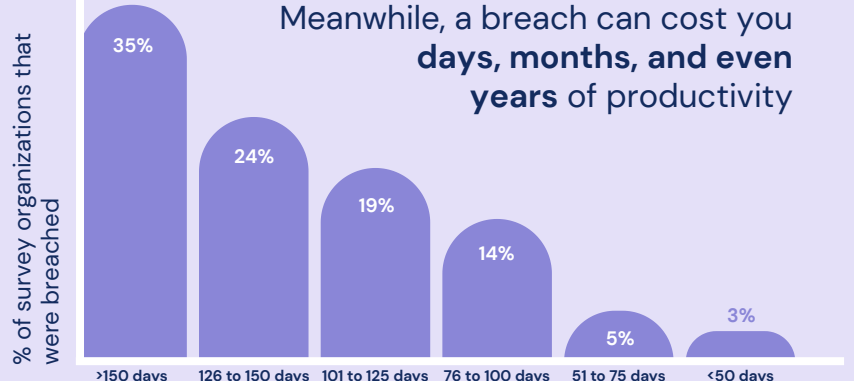
How much time does it really take?

Multi-Factor Authentication
30 seconds/login x 5 logins = 2.5 min

Security Awareness Training
5 min or less /month = 1 hour/year

Software Updates
Automatic and can be done overnight

Review emails for phishing
7 seconds/email x 100 emails < 12 min
